## ☞ WHITE WINES ☞

**SAUVIGNON BLANC** is a wildly versatile grape. It's flavors can range from very green, grassy, and citrusy to tropical and melon like. In the Bordeaux region of France the tradition is to oak age the wine and blend it with Semillon for a richer style. The high natural acidity makes this wine a great match with food.

**PINOT GRIS** taste of honey and stone fruit flavors which add complexity to these light wines. Don't let the fruity aromas of the Alsatian style deceive you, the wines are dry. Pinot Grigio, the alter ego of Pinot Gris, is an Italian style that is clean and relatively neutral.

**GEWURZTRAMINER** is a pink skinned grape famous for it's spicy flavor and rose petal aromas. It is most at home in the Alsace region of France but has growing success in the cooler regions of the United States. It can be made dry or sweet.

**RIESLING** is a classic German grape that produces wines that range in flavor from tart green apple to succulent honeycomb. Riesling grows best in cool climates where the natural acidity aids in its ability to age. Whether dry or sweet, the wines have great complexity and are great accompaniments to food.

**CHENIN BLANC** *At home in the Loire Valley of France, this grape has become increasingly popular around the world. The wines are medium bodied and have flavors of golden apples and bees wax.*

**ROSÉ** wines are synonymous with summer picnics on the beach. Meant to drink young and fresh, many rosés are a byproduct of red wine making. By bleeding off a bit of pink juice, the ratio of skins to wine goes up. This makes for more saturated red wines and a little pink wine to enjoy while it ages.

**PINOT NOIR** The thin skins of this grape make for a softer, more aromatic wine. The wines are full of red fruit flavors like raspberry, red cherry, and pomegranate. Pinot Noir is juicy and rich, but understated enough to allow great food to shine.

**GRENAICHE** is the star of Mediterranean Europe. The wines are lush and medium bodied with pepper and toasted herb flavors adding complexity. Grenache is often blended with Syrah to be like the famous wine Châteauneuf-du-Pape, from the Southern Rhone.

**SYRAH** *Because the name of this grape is derived from Shiraz, the capital of Fars, the idea has sprung up that this variety must have originated in Persia. We now know that it is pure French in its breeding. The grape makes violet colored red wines with pepper and smoke flavors.*

**PETITE SIRAH** *is an ancient cross between Syrah and Peloursin, although most of the vines identified as petite Sirah are actually the grape Durif, from Southern France. The wine is inky black and concentrated.*

**ZINFANDEL** *has been long thought to be a truly American varietal, genetic fingerprinting has traced this grapes origin to Croatia, where it is called Crljenak Kastelanski. By either name, the result is a juicy, jammy wine with flavors of boysenberry and blueberry.*

**MERLOT** produces nicely colored wines, soft in fruit but capable of great richness. It is invaluable in Bordeaux, bringing fruity lushness and a velvet quality to wines that might be otherwise rather hard and austere. It is the chief grape in Château Petrus, one of the top wines in the world.

**CABERNET FRANC** The father of the Cabernet Sauvignon grape, this grape is most often found in blends. It does well on it's own in the Loire Valley of France and in cooler parts of the US. The wine has a soft texture and a light herbal tone to match against the ripe cassis and cherry flavors.

**CABERNET SAUVIGNON** is the noblest grape variety of Bordeaux is also probably the noblest grape variety of the US. Known for great structure and weight the complexities that this grape can achieve transcend simplistic comparisons to cedar, blackcurrants, or violets.

**MERITAGE** is pronounced like heritage. Meritage wines first appeared in the late 1980s after a group of American vintners joined forces to create a name for New World wines blended in the tradition of Bordeaux. The word was selected from more than 6,000 entries in an international contest. Meritage combines "merit" and "heritage". The allowed red grapes are Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Malbec, and Petit Verdot and the blend can not be more than 75% of any one grape.
